Athletes only develop skills through structured practice and technique can't be effectively taught while individuals are competing for scores. For these reasons, we will be introducing our youth developmental league format which will incorporate formal structured practices (primarily on Thursday) and formal competition days (Sundays starting week 2). No games for score will be bowled on any practice day.

Competition days will bowl either 2 or 3 games based upon age / skill level. Bowlers will be organized into Teams after the first 2 practice days have been completed. Competition scores will count toward league awards and state-level tournament qualifiers. Bowlers will also be entered into the IL State BPA Grand Prix program which allows them to earn college scholarship money through participation and for High School bowlers a special scholarship tournament at the end of the season.
